and what some call progress is nature we stole

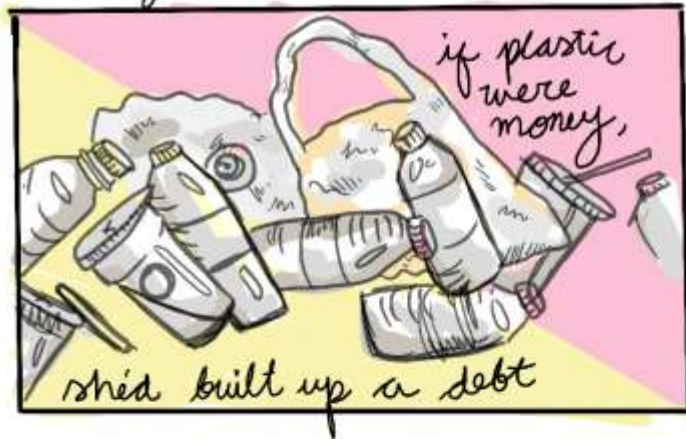
**EACH PERSON RESPONSIBLE**

the hardworking bees were naught but a threat;



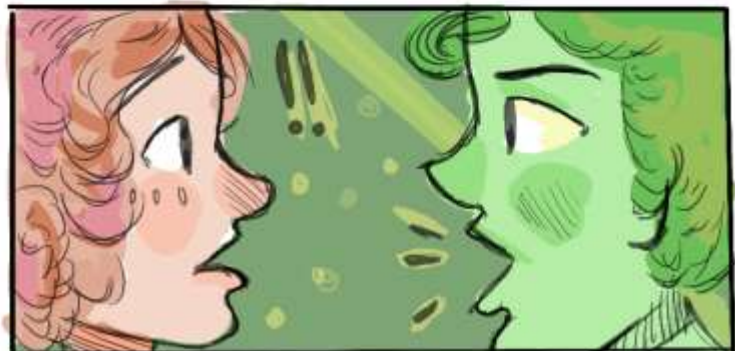
if plastic were money,

she'd built up a debt



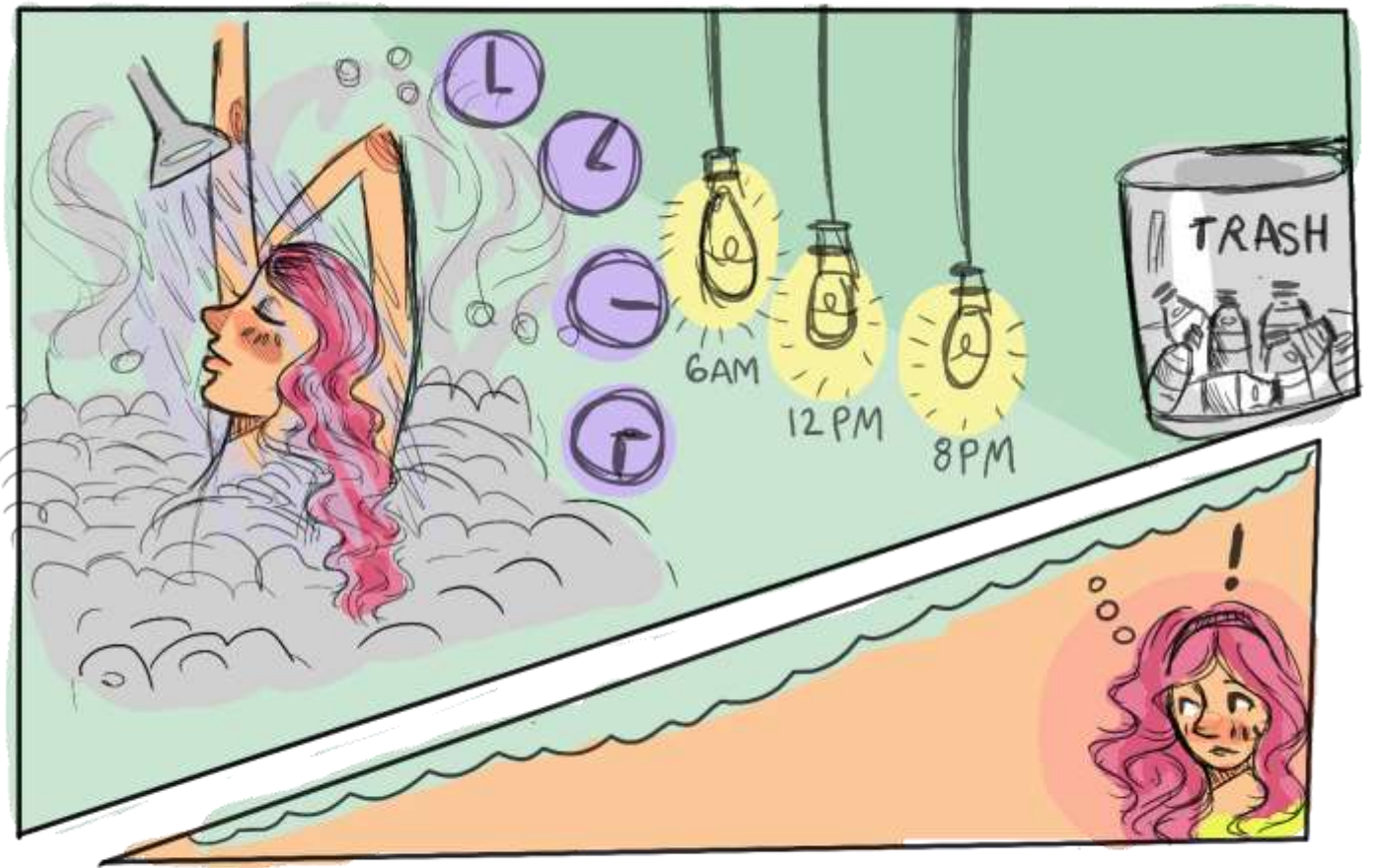
HER ONLY ENCOUNTER WITH NATURE BY CHOICE WAS THE WOODS BY her school-

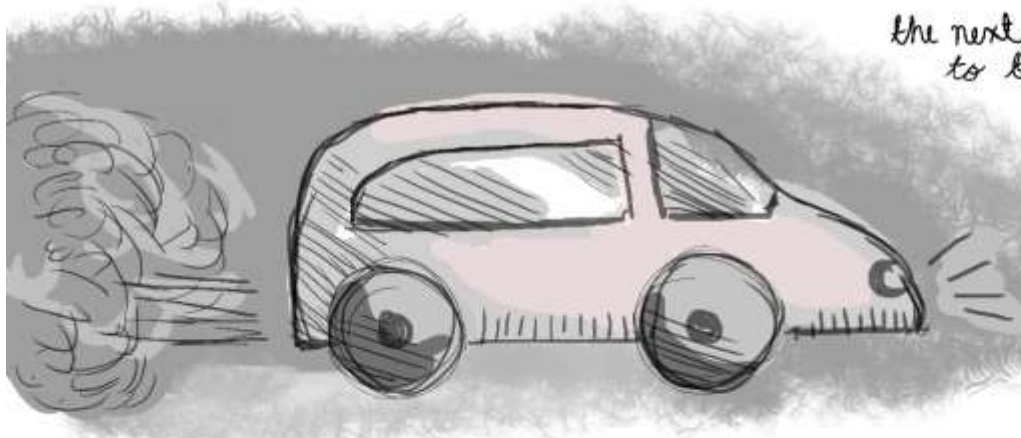
there she heard a strange voice...

to be sure

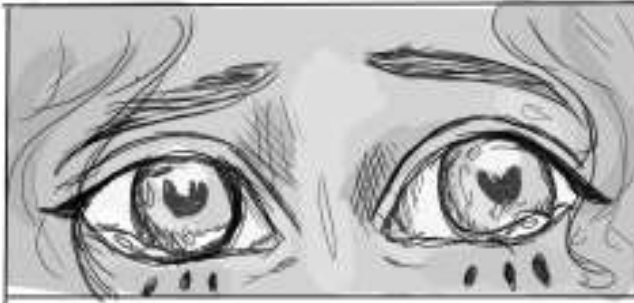
a day away from

began to CRY.

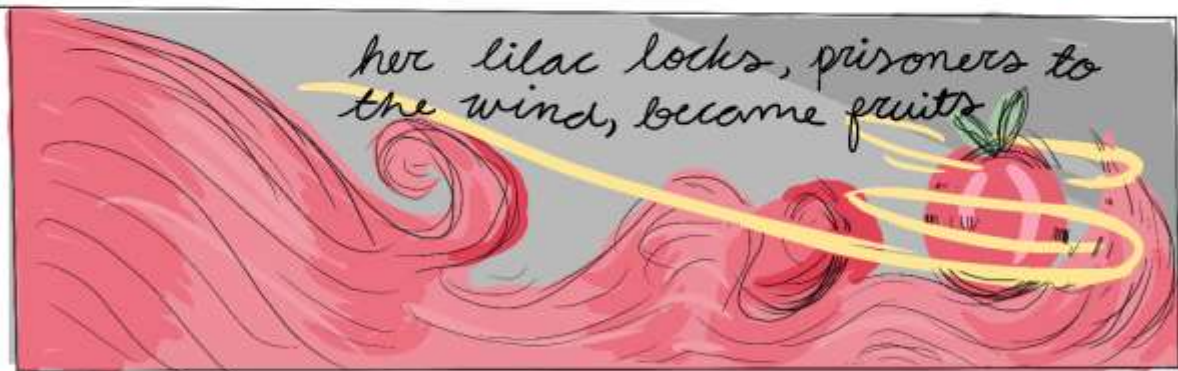


"Maybe," SHE THOUGHT,
